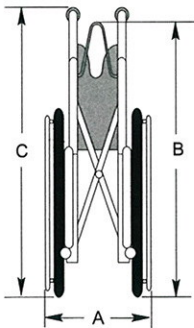
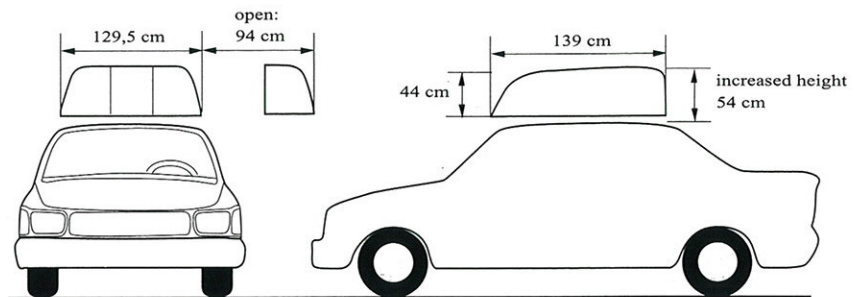
The Chair Topper 2002 stores a foldable wheelchair easily and safely, leaving your car's interior clean and dry. With a weight of only 55 kg the weather-tight fibreglass compartment can be mounted on most vehicle models. Including wheelchair the total weight does not exceed 75 kg.

Fix the folded cross frame wheelchair to the retractable lift arm and start loading. The fully automatic loading process takes about 30 seconds and is operated by a hand control pendant. You don't have to worry about staining the inside of your car and the luggage compartment is left unrestricted.

The roof box adds only 54 cm total height to the vehicle, maintaining "garageability" and is available in driver- and passenger-side models.

- Hand control operated.
- Stows in 30 seconds.
- Alluminium frame. Base/top in ABS plastic.
- Low profile override access cover.
- Available in left or right side loading.
- Low friction side tracks.
- Sealed motors.
- No exposed rivets on the exterior.
- Fully enclosed to be weather tight.
